## ETHNIC SCHOLAR, MAKALAH CANNON, LISTENS TO GOD'S CALL

Family time, Girl Scouts, track and band add meaning to Makalah Cannon's life. But right now, school takes precedence for the young African-American woman from Lithonia, GA. Now a student at the University of West Georgia in Carrollton, GA, Makalah has already taken the Certified Nursing Assistant course, which offered handson experience. She recently applied to nursing school.

"Growing up," Makalah recalled, "my life was very fun." Her mother worked for the school system so always had summers off. Makalah, her brother and their mom traveled and participated in activities at Stone Mountain and the Center for Puppetry Arts in Atlanta.

Makalah is grateful for her faith family's role in her life. "The United Methodist Church," she said, "has supported my upbringing by giving me a church home, a foundation and a doctrine grounded in structure, which helps me in my daily studies. My church has been my support throughout my childhood years and has ingrained in me the importance of praying, biblical teachings and United Methodist beliefs. They have given me the mindset that I am able to do anything I put my mind to do."

She heard about the Ethic Scholarship, supported by the offering on World Communion Sunday, through her

church, Andrews Chapel United Methodist, Jonesboro, GA.

"Receiving this scholarship," she noted, "has helped my life tremendously. With my brother recently graduating from college with a significant amount of student-loan debt, it has been a struggle for my parents to pay his debt and my student expenses as well. Any scholarship money I receive is truly a blessing." Already, Makalah knows that the road to becoming a nurse is tough.

"Many times," she admitted, "I get really stressed out and overwhelmed and start to think I cannot do this. However, I know that this is what God has called me on this earth to do, so I depend on my faith to get me through the hard times. It may not be easy, but it will be worth it."

Makalah's goal is to become a registered nurse, working with neonatal or geriatric patients. "As a successful nurse," she said, "I will focus on quality patient care and making people's lives better each day. I would also like to pursue my master's in nursing in hopes of becoming a nurse practitioner.

One of six churchwide Special Sundays with offerings of The United Methodist Church, World Communion Sunday calls the church to reach out to all people and model diversity among God's children. October receipts were \$1,389 lower than budgeted. Mission Giving Expenses were favorable as we did not make an apportionment payment in October. Trustee expenses were favorable as a result of overpaying utilities in September and using the credit in October. Lay Personnel expense was favorable primarily the result of a budgeted but unfilled Choir Director position.

Our operating cash balance on October 31, 2019 was a positive \$2,534. This resulted as we transferred \$10,000 from our TMF Operating account.

As you can note, our spending continues to exceed our contributions. As a result we continue to spend our reserve funds. It is important that we find a way to meet our expense needs through our contributions. We look forward to any suggestions you have. The Finance Committee thanks you for your support to St. Mark's. Rio Texas "The Church Conference directs the Trustees of the church to begin negotiations with Project Transformation Rio Texas for the purposes and intent to transfer to Project Transformation Rio Texas ownership of the building known as Lovely Lane, a portion of real estate surrounding that building, and the parking lot on the south side of the sanctuary. Upon reaching a successful agreement, the Trustees may transfer the property in accordance with church and civil laws."

The Trustees will be removing things from Lovely Lane in December. There are some crosses and other items that someone may like to have returned. If they want them, they need to make arrangements soon so they won't be lost or destroyed. Questions may be directed to John Williams.
