Finance Committee Reflections: Sounds From the Bean Counters

It seems that, after a very short spring, we have quickly entered the summer season.

Our April contributions surpassed both the budget and April 2012. Year-to-date contributions lag both the budget ans 2012; however, only \$687 less than budget.

April operating expenses are higher than 2012 and the budget. The most significant variances were Mission Giving and Trustee Expenses. As a result of the Easter collection being designated for apportionments, we paid over \$8,000 towards apportionments (Mission Giving). Trustee expenses were higher, primarily the result of parking lot repairs. Year-to-date operating expenses are greater than 2012, but less than budgeted. Lay Personnel expense and Trustee expenses are the most favorable to the budget.

For the month of April, we had a cash inflow of \$2,211 while year-to-date then inflow is \$4,962.

Through April, we have paid \$13,022 towards our apportionments. This is still \$1,760 lower than budget, but exceeds the amount paid through April 2012 by \$3,850.

Our operating cash balance at the end of April was \$9,346 compared to \$7,699 at the end of March.

Our financial condition continues to be good. We have a positive cash flow and a positive operating cash balance. Without your financial support, this would not be possible. We thank you all very much and we pray the strong support continues through the summer months.

A Note from the Pastor...

I hope that everyone has been following the daily devotion and prayer time that is so much a part of the book "Catch Fire in 50 Days". I passed 70 copies of this book out at the end of last Sunday's worship service, one per family with the instruction for us to read and pray from this guide daily throughout the season of Pentecost (50 days). If you were absent that day or just somehow missed out on this gift, please give me a call at the church office and I'll make sure you get one. It seems that most of the people that I've talked to have, indeed, taken the challenge to be transformed by God's Holy Spirit through the means of grace we call prayer. At every gathering I'll ask, "Are y'all reading this faithfully, daily?" and hands shoot up with nods of "yes!" and I'm just delighted. Something powerful and miraculous takes place when the people of God pray!

What I like about the book, besides just the daily activity of reading Scripture (which we can get from so many sources: the Bible, the Upper Room, other devotionals, etc) are the types of reflective questions that are asked each day. They are not complicated; pretty simple and direct...and yet, if we truthfully answer them, I believe that there is a level of depth and honesty that demands a level of growth beyond just a casual reading of text. Questions like: "What would you have to let go of in order to allow for an in-breaking of Christ in your life?" or "What role does fear play in your struggle to be an agent of God's mission in the world?" or "What is the evidence in your life that you have been raised with Christ?"...you know, things like that!

It only takes me a few minutes (barely) to read each devotion...but I reflect on the questions and my answers all day! I hope that you do, too. It will be exciting to see the vision that God brings to us at the end of these 50 days. It will be awesome to sense the depth and growth that we will experience as companions who have committed to each other and Christ to pray together. "Surely the presence of the Lord is in this place! I can feel His mighty power and His grace! I can hear the brush of angel's wings, I see glory on each face...surely the presence of the Lord is in this place!"

Hallelujah! Amen! God bless you, I'll see you in church,


